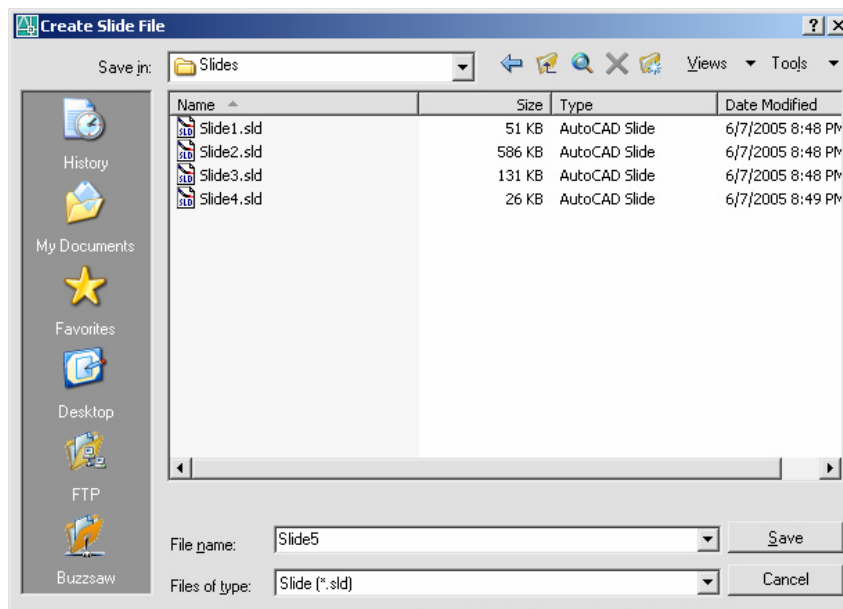

39.1 MSlide Command

1. **Type** MSLIDE at the command prompt.
Command: **MSLIDE**
2. **Type** the name of the slide file (and location).

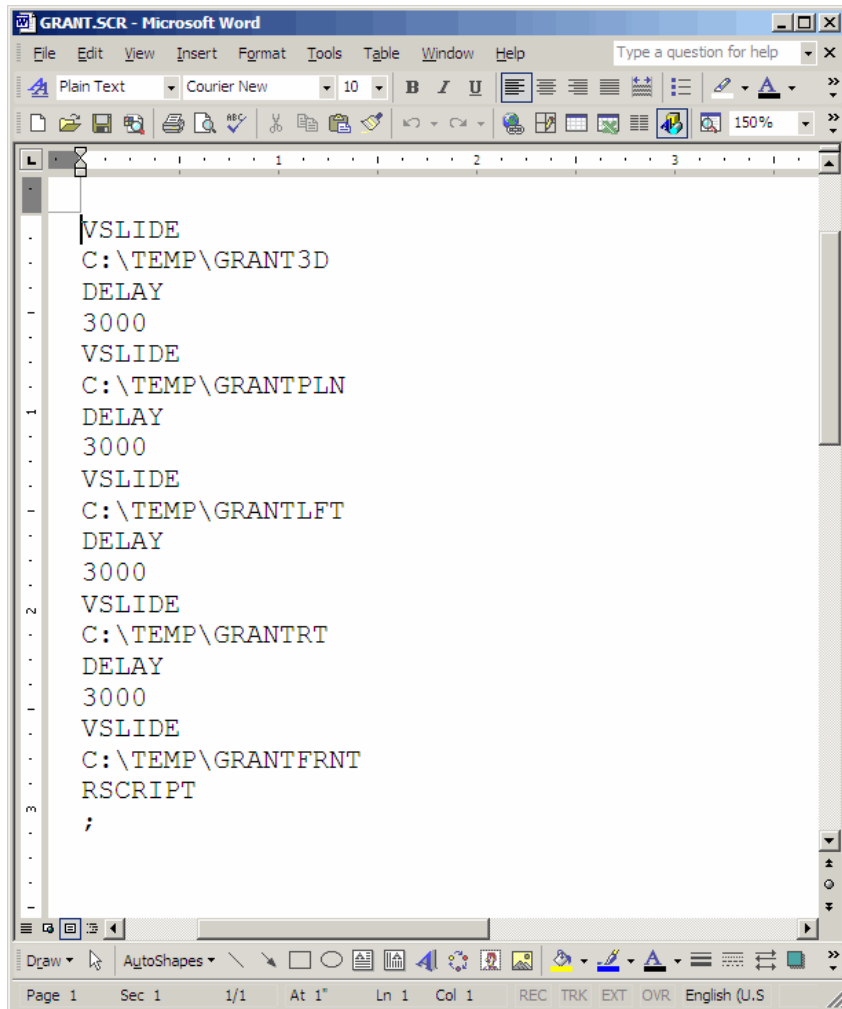

39.2 Scripts

In a Word Processor, create a series of commands to execute in AutoCAD.

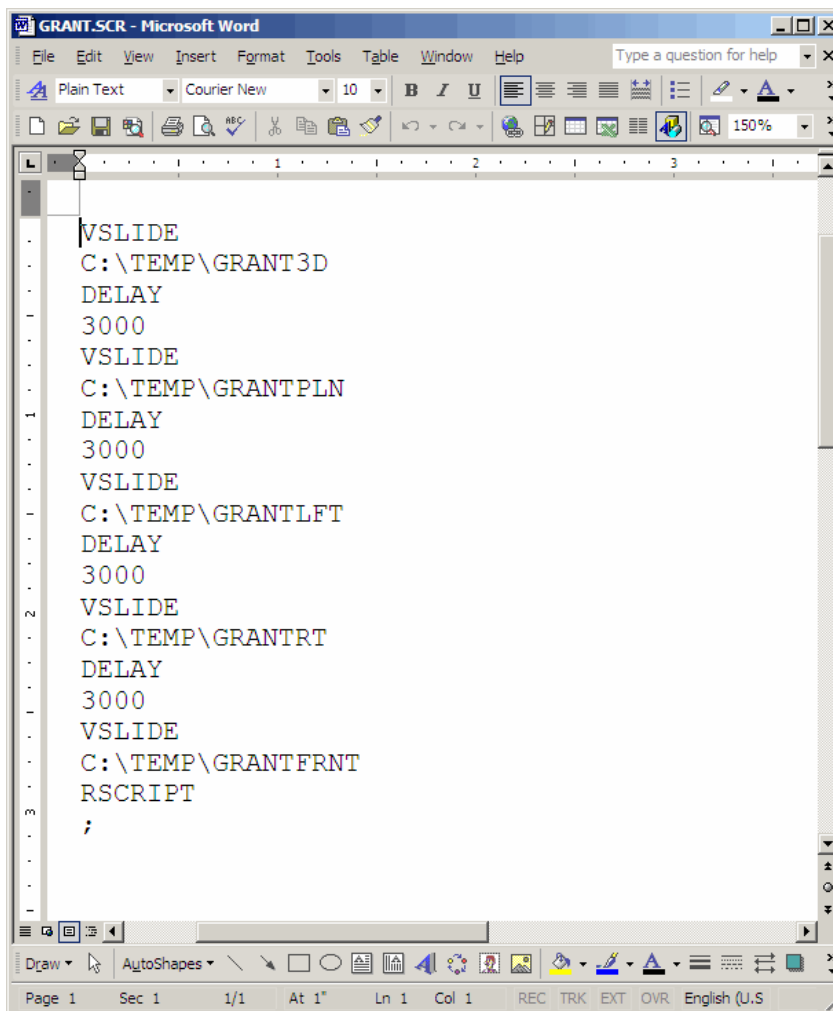
Save the script file with an extension called **.SCR**.

39.3 Pausing a Slide

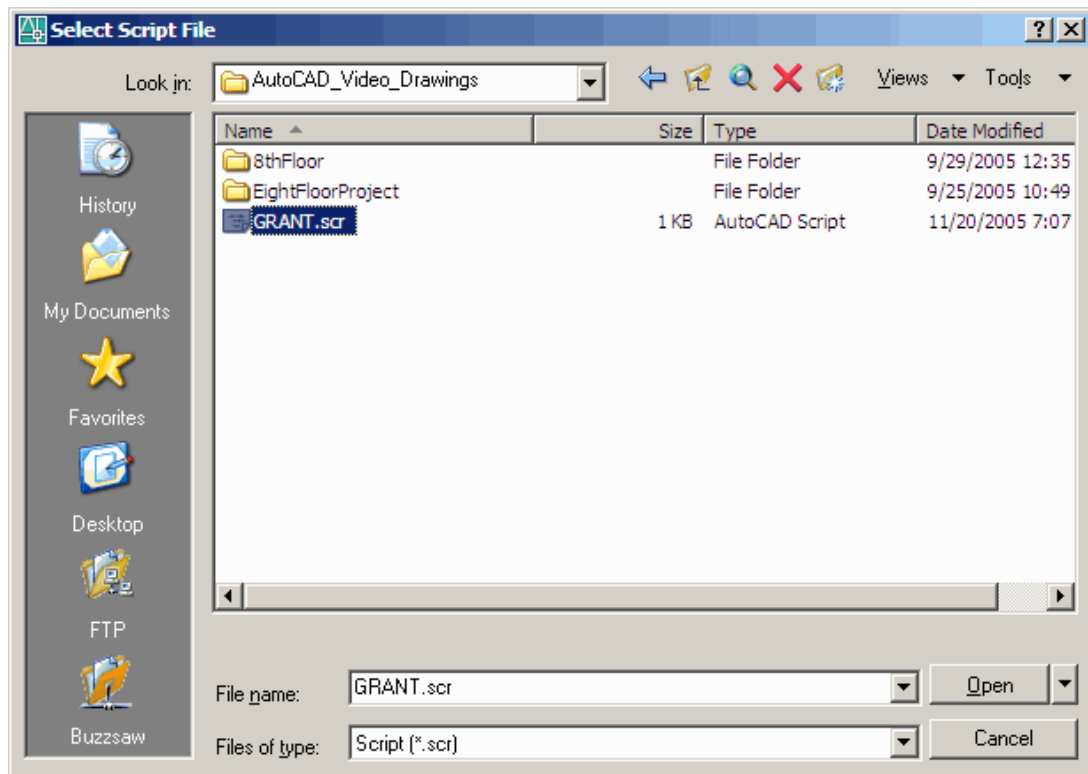
1. **Type** DELAY at the command prompt.
Command: **DELAY**
Enter delay time (in milliseconds): **3000**
NOTE: 3000 milliseconds is 3 seconds

39.4 Running a Script in AutoCAD

1. **Type** SCRIPT at the command prompt.
Command: **SCRIPT**
2. **Pick** the script name to run.



39.5 Repeating a Script

1. **Type** RSCRIPT at the command prompt.
Command: **RSCRIPT**
This will repeat the script command lines continuously.
