1. INFORMATION

Whether your speech provides sufficient information of your hotel: location and facility (e.g., with what your hotel is equipped, and what guests can do.)

2. CREATIVITY

How your speech consists of original and creative ideas.

表現 (expression) 0-----1-----2-----3-----4-----5

3. GRAMMATICALITY/COMPREHENSIBILITY

Your ability to formulate grammatical and comprehensible sentences.

4. VOCABULARY & STRUCTURE

Your ability to appropriately use various vocabulary, and your ability to present ideas in a coherent manner. The vocabulary should mainly come from the textbook. New words must be limited to avoid confusion and clearly defined if necessary.

5. PRESENTATION MANNER

Your ability to present the material with appropriate facial and body expressions with enthusiasm. In order to make your speech interactive and appealing to the audience, your speech must be memorized. You may use cards on which outlines have been written down. 6. FLUENCY & CLARITY

Your ability to maintain oral production without interruptions or sudden stops.

Your ability to pronounce Japanese clearly and accurately.
