





## Well-staffed Orphanages


- Positive effects for leaving but depended on where.
  - Adopted had higher IQ and Reading than those returned to biological parents
  - Adopted mutual attachments regardless of age at adoption
  - Biological returnees attachment decrees with age of return






































## In-Class Assignment
