Dr. Kim is currently a professor at Civil Engineering Department of Kyungnam University in Republic of Korea. His research has been contributed to improve physico-chemical processes in water treatment. He has recently expanded his research interest into membrane-based seawater desalination, and is now leading a mega research project aimed to develop future seawater desalination technologies such as membrane distillation and pressure retarded osmosis.
