He received both B.S and M.S in physics from Seoul National University, Korea, and Ph.D from Michigan State U. He was also a faculty member at Korea Air Force Academy, while he held a rank of Lieutenant in Korean Air Force. His research in theoretical and computational condensed matter physics and materials physics has produced more than 25 scientific papers including 10 in Physical Review Letter. In addition, he holds 3 US patents and 5 US patent applications in nanoscience and nanotechnology</p>
