**In-Hong Choi** received her M.D. degree from Yonsei University in 1980 and her Ph.D. degree in Immunology from the same university in 1986.

Dr. Choi studied the T cell receptor and autoimmunity at the Division of Molecular Medicine, North Shore University Hospital, N.Y. from 1991-1993, and neuroimmunology at the Walter and Eliza Hall Institute, Melbourne, Australia, 2000 as a visiting scientist. She has been a member of the Korean Society of Immunology since 1986 and the American Society of Immunologists since 1993. At present she is the chairperson of the Institute for Immunology and Immunological Diseases, Yonsei University Medical College.

Dr. Choi's main field of study is innate immunity and inflammation. Cytokines and signaling pathways involved in immune responses triggered by immunologically foreign materials are her major interest. She also is working on the toxicology and inflammation induced by nanomaterials.
