Scheduling

Volunteers will work in blocks for both the Murrysville road race on the 22nd and for the downtown bridge criterium on the 23rd. Please see www.steelcityshowdown.com for more information about race venues. We're asking all volunteers to **PLEASE ARRIVE AN HOUR BEFORE THE BEGINNING OF YOUR SHIFT** so we can serve food and drive you out to your location on the course.

Block 2: 12:30 pm – 5:30 pm

Bus transportation will be provided for all shifts on both the 22nd and 23rd. Buses for block 1 will leave the UC turnaround at 6:30 am and again at 11:00 am for block 2 volunteers.

Brief Description of Tasks

Marshals

Marshals are responsible for directing traffic and racers at various points along the course. We will provide all volunteers with the necessary equipment (flags, bright clothing, radios, etc.).

Caravan

The caravan is intended to safely escort the main pack of racers along the course and provide a noticeable barrier of support between riders and traffic.

Volunteer Support

The volunteer support vehicles will be provided by the University of Pittsburgh, and are intended to transport volunteers to and from their posts while maintaining constant contact with the volunteers for any additional support.

Registration

The registration volunteers are in charge of checking in racers, verifying licenses, and administering one-day licensing to all collegiate and USCF cyclists.
