## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," further providing for oath of office. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 321 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, 8 No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, amended 10 November 22, 1968 (P.L.1079, No.331), is amended to read: Section 321. Compensation; Oath of Office. -- All persons 11 12 elected or appointed as school directors shall serve without pay 13 except as hereinafter provided. Before entering upon the duties of their office each shall take and subscribe to the following 14 15 oath or affirmation, which shall also be given to 16 superintendents, assistant superintendents, principals, assistant principals and business managers, and which may be 17 18 administered by any one qualified to administer an oath, or as

- I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will support, obey and
- 2 defend the Constitution of the United States and the
- 3 Constitution of this Commonwealth, <a href="thicker: that I will allocate school">this Commonwealth</a>, <a href="thicker: this thin this commonwealth">that I will allocate school</a>
- 4 resources and effect educational policy solely for the purpose
- 5 of ensuring that each student learns to his or her intellectual\_
- 6 capacity, and that I will discharge the duties of my office with
- 7 fidelity.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
