Objective	To construct a space with the documentation provided by others.
Method	As an architect, you will be asked to make drawings and other items of representation to inform others of your own design intent.
Process	Each group is to visit another studio (Yellow to Red, Red to Blue, and Blue to Yellow) and distribute your drawings to another group. No other forms of communication are allowed. Each group is to reconstruct the construction produced by the other. Groups are not allowed to ask each other for interpretations of the drawings.
Site	The "CMU Cut" in front of the University Center / Purnell Center
Materials	Something to cut the string 3 smooth stones or weights Ball of string
Things you might consider	How are the drawings you prepared similar to the ones you are using? How are the drawings you prepared different from the ones you are using? What do you wish you had to help aid you in the reconstruction?
Project & Presentation Requirements	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. You must be completed by 3.00 p.m. sharp and present the construction to an instructor.2. Meet with a minimum of one member of the previous group to discuss how your construction is similar to the original. The group who was the originator of the construction is to provide a critique of its success.3. When completed, you and your team must clean up your creation entirely, no later than 4.00 p.m. Return all of the materials in the crate to the hall near your studio.4. At 4.00 p.m. meet back in the studio to receive the next project.
