Project 2: BUILDING ANALYSIS

Each student will be assigned a building and an associated architectural construction detail that helps define the building's identity and spacial experience. The assignment will be to do research, and present an in-depth analysis and understanding of one particular aspect of the building in the form of a "drawing" or "diagram."

Assignment 2a (for Friday. Feb. 10, 1:30)


1) Read Alberto Perez-Gomez, "Architecture as Drawing,' J. of Arch'l Education (1982)

2) Do research on your building, architect, context. Begin with the citation listed with your building, and expand your research to find many sources (books and articles) to understand it in different contexts. 3) Write a 1-page synopsis on the architectural significance of the building; upload to Blackboard BLOG for your studio (see "Studio Blogs" button on main menu, over email)

4) Create an 11x17 (landscape format) summary of your building. Include photos and drawings, a brief summary of the significance, and a bibliography of important sources.




