DE STIJL = NEO-PLASTICISM

De Stijl group & De Stijl magazine founded 1917, P. Mondrian, T.v. Doesburg, G. Vantongerloo, J.J.P. Oud, R.v.t Hoff, C.v. Eesteren and others..

- * Read De Stijl Manifestoes in Conrads' Programs & Manifestoes
 - End of individualism, natural & arbitrary form
 - Seek universal, abstract form / relationships
 - Unity, not separation, of art/life, arch./sculpture, inside/out, color/arch....
 - Arch. as fluid unity of space, planes, color...
