Named Views 28.1

Ddview Command

1. **Choose** View, Named Views...


or

2. **Click** the Named View icon from the View toolbar.




3. **Type** DDVIEW at the command prompt.

Command: **DDVIEW**



- 4. **Choose** the NEW button.
- 5. **Type** a view name.
- 6. **Choose** Current display or Define Window.



Typing the View Command

1. **Type** View at the command prompt. Command: **-VIEW**

2. **Type** One of the following view options:

?/Delete/Restore/Save/Window:

View options:

? Lists the named views for this drawing


Delete Deletes the named view

Restore Displays the specified view

Save Attaches a name to the current view of the drawing

Window Attaches a name to specified window


Plotting Named Views 28.2




Viewports 28.3

Vports Command

- 1. **Choose** View, Viewports, New Viewports...
- 2. **Choose** one of the viewports configurations
- 3. Click OK.



- 4. **Click** once in each vport to make it active.
- 5. **Type** a ZOOM option in each viewport.



Viewport options

New Name Gives a name to a viewport

Restore Restores an original viewport

Delete DEL deletes a viewport

Join Joins two viewports together

Single Creates on viewport in the drawing

TIPS:

Viewports can be named and restored later.

AutoCAD plots only the current vport.
