Compendex (Engineering Index) – can also search with **Inspec** + **NTIS**. Interdisciplinary bibliographic engineering database – goes back to 1884.

Credo Reference – medical dictionaries and encyclopedia entries.

Encyclopedia of Medical Devices & Instrumentation

IEEE Xplore – includes access to *IEEE Transactions on Biomedical Engineering* and *Engineering in Medicine and Biology* conference proceedings.

Kirk-Othmer Encyclopedia of Chemical Technology – up-to-date topics. Summaries include applied chemical science and biotechnology.

Knovel – 2,000+ full-text manuals, handbooks, & encyclopedias + data analysis tools.

MetaLib – multiple database search. Try *Basic Search*: "Engineering/Tech" category.

PubMed – U.S. National Library of Medicine/National Institutes of Health. Free search engine to biomedical literature/MEDLINE \rightarrow <u>TUTORIALS</u> \rightarrow <u>Pubget</u> for PDFs

SciFinder Scholar – access to Chemical Abstracts, technical reports & patents.

Synthesis Digital Library – Synthesis Lectures on Biomedical Engineering.

Testing & Education Reference Center – MCAT and other graduate practice tests.
