

Steve Badanes is an award-winning architect and educator in the area of design/build. He holds the Howard Wright Endowed Chair of Architecture at the University of Washington, where he leads design/build studios that have focused on community service projects for non-profit organizations in the Seattle area. In addition, he co-founded the Mexico design/build program with UW Professor Sergio Palleroni, and has taught design/build workshops and community service projects in Finland, Africa, and many universities in this country, as well as the Yestermorrow design/build school in Vermont. He has lectured on the topic in 46 states and 10 countries.



Badanes is also the founder of Jersey Devil, an architectural firm perpetuating the tradition of medieval craftsmen. Jersey Devil architect/builders live on-site during construction of their designs, which are known for craft and detail, attention to the expressiveness of the construction materials, and a strong environmental consciousness. Badanes has authored two books about the firm: The Jersey Devil Design/Build Book (1985) and Devil's Workshop: 25 Years of Jersey Devil Architecture (1997).
