LOT/EK is an architecture studio based in New York City. It was founded in 1993 by Ada Tolla and Giuseppe Lignano, both of whom are coming to Pittsburgh to speak! Since then, LOT/EK has been involved in residential and commercial projects here and abroad, and site-specific exhibits and installations at major cultural institutions such as NYC's MoMA, Whitney, and Guggenheim Museums. Tolla and Lignano have degrees from Naples, Italy and Columbia University, teach at Parsons in NYC, and have lectured around the world. The office has received high visibility for its innovative approach to construction, materials and space, and for the use of technology as an integral part of architecture.
