

JMol Fix

How to get Jmol running on most machines:

1. Use Firefox.
2. Download the latest version of Java (you probably have Java on your machine, if not install it by going to: <https://java.com/en/download/>).
3. Add the course web site to the Java site exception list by doing the following (see image below):
 - a) Go to the control panel (PC) or the equivalent on a Mac (Preferences?)
 - b) View by small icons
 - c) Click on the “Java” icon, it takes a few seconds to open.
 - d) After the “Java Control Panel” is open, click on the “Security” tab at the top.
 - e) Make sure “Enable Java content in the browser” is checked.
 - f) Click on “Edit Site List...”, then “Add”
 - g) Type the URL for the directory (folder) that you are trying to access.
For genes, drugs, and disease you should type: https://www.andrew.cmu.edu/user/rule/03_131/
Note that the URL should begin with https:, not http:, and that you need to include the last backslash (/).
 - h) Click on “OK” to close the Security tab.
 - i) Click on “OK” to close the Java Control Panel.
4. Add the course site to your bookmarks (for easy return), then re-launch Firefox, return to the site.
